Reflection

Although divine power is manifested in dramatic ways, it is also present in what is unassuming. Traces of God can be seen in the delicacy of a violet, in a cool summer breeze, in the blush of innocence, in the fiery eyes of justice. Every one of us lives in the midst of God, breathes the breath of God's life, and is constantly touched by the exquisite artistry of God's creativity. Life itself is a mountain experience of God.

As wonderful as life may be, it can also be very frightening at times. There are misunderstandings and rancour, jealousy and vindictiveness, greed and a hunger for power. Our personal lives can come unravelled and we can feel that we are genuinely 'at sea'. Every human being is tossed about by the exigencies of life. It is at times like these that we need faith in Jesus. Even though we do not recognise him, he is there in the midst of our chaos. Having the power of God, he is the definitive champion of all chaos, and so he is able to allay our fears and calm the sea.

A true experience of God, whether it be within the ordinariness of life or one of life's tribulations, is both transformative and effusive. It is a reality that cannot be contained; it must be proclaimed. Disciples must be ready to do what they can in order that the good news of God's revelation be made known to others.

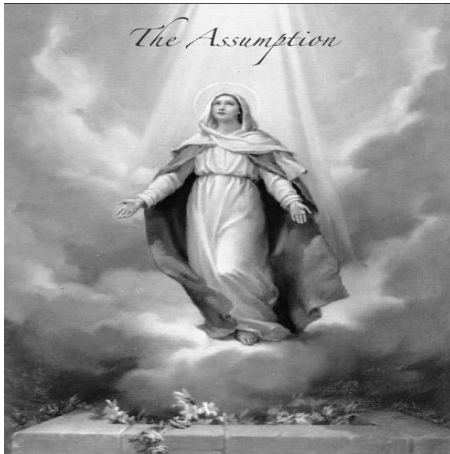

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION:

To commemorate the feast day of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Vigil mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of the Rosary Church Taree on Friday, 14th August 2020 at 5.30pm and a Solemnity Mass will be celebrated on Saturday 15th August, 2020 at 9.30am.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: Due to Covid-19 restrictions please be mindful of the following rules and regulations.

1. Parishioners **must** book via the Parish office, 6552 1084 Tuesday to Friday 9.00am to 3.00pm. **You must provide contact details or be refused entry.**

2. Please be mindful that the Mass numbers are limited. Booking for both a Saturday and Sunday will not be possible nor courteous.

3. We will not and cannot exceed the numbers so please do not turn up without a booking or attempt to admit yourself to a service once it has commenced.

4. Please do not attend the SCAE or Mass service if you are not feeling well.

5. All parishioners will need to be signed in and escorted to a seat. It is a requirement to sanitise your hands upon arrival at the doors even if wearing gloves.

6. Please observe physical distancing.

7. Hymn books etc have been removed from the Church, as has Holy Water.

8. The Congregation is not permitted to sing.

9. Communion will only be administered via the officiating priest, and collections will be made via collection baskets at the altar.

10. Please observe these requirements inside and outside the Church grounds.

Mary of the Cross, (born January 15, 1842, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia — died August 8, 1909, North Sydney, New South Wales, Australia; canonized October 17, 2010; religious figure, educator, and social reformer who was the first Australian beatified by the Roman Catholic Church and the first Australian to be recognized as one of its saints.
