FIRST READING: Rv 7:2-4. 9-14 I saw an immense crowd, beyond hope of counting, of people from every nation, race, tribe and language.

SECOND READING: 1 Jn 3:1-3 We shall see God as he really is.

FIRST READING: Wis 6:12-16 Wisdom is found by those who look for it.

SECOND READING: 1 Thes 4:13-18 Those who died as Christians, God will bring to life with Jesus.

GOSPEL: Mt 25:1-13 Look, the bridegroom comes. Go out to meet him.

Reflection

Today we celebrate the memory of all the baptised who have gone before us and whose lives were virtuous. The saints of God are all those who have been baptised into Christ, who have washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb. We all know people whose lives were steeped in genuine holiness. The life of every one of us has been blessed by their goodness. This is a day for us to remember and to celebrate their holiness. We celebrate the lives of all those who have been marked with the sign of faith, those who have been canonised by the church, those whom we have known personally as well as those whose names we do not know.

In the beatitudes listed in today's gospel we are given examples of what it means to live lives of holiness. This gospel really does not present a blueprint for holiness. Rather, it offers a series of snapshots that demonstrate the holiness that is ours by virtue of our baptism. Those who have gone before us lived such lives. Today, as we remember them, we hold up their lives as examples of holiness and models for our imitation. The sentiments that are expressed and the commitment that it illustrated in the beatitudes clearly stand in opposition to the standards of the world. Their radicality may be more than some can understand, but they are traits that are recognisable by those who belong to the family of God, for they are genuine godly traits.
