The Sacrament of Confirmation

Chrism

This is the name of the oil with which the children were anointed with on their foreheads. It is a word very much like Jesus' title "the Christ". When we are anointed with the Oil of Chrism we are each given a share in the very strengthening Spirit of Christ. This is a strengthening of the Spirit first given at Baptism which made us children of God.

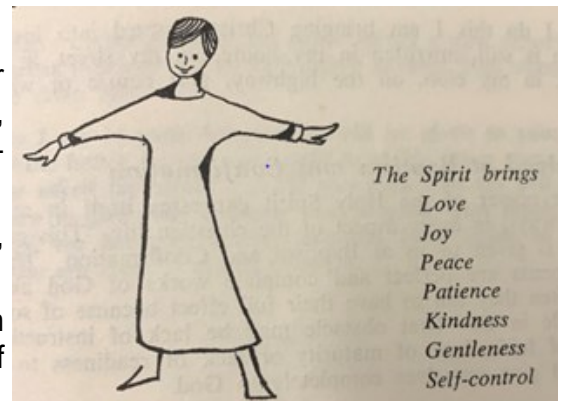
When speaking of the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, St Paul says "The love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given to us" (Rom 5:5). This is why St Paul can say that in his life "it is Christ who lives in me" (Gals 2:19) so our Christian life is not simply a struggle. With the Spirit as our Helper, we have the power to love and serve God and to overcome what St Paul calls "self-indulgence". Instead the fruits of the Spirit are these;

RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF RCIA IN OUR PARISHES MEETING THIS TUESDAY 6.00PM- 7.00PM ST MARY'S HALL

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is what our Catholic Church provides for those who may not be Baptised and who wish to be prepared to become part of the Catholic Church. Over many years, parishioners have provided assistance to those seeking to become part of our Catholic Faith.

The RCIA preparation time is one of formation which provides a context for both ongoing learning and prayer. The Instruction on the RCIA puts emphasis upon the **whole parish community** contributing to this journey of formation- both in preparation for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) and afterwards. Parish Priests, Deacons and members of the parish community like sponsors assist. Also some parishioners are invited to exercise a lay catechist ministry to assist with instruction and the RCIA rites. A time of learning and formation is also arranged for those already baptised and who request to be received into the Church.

There will be an information evening on the RCIA on this Tuesday evening at 6.00pm- 7.00pm and which any parishioner is welcome to attend. You may indicate your availability to assist in some way or other.

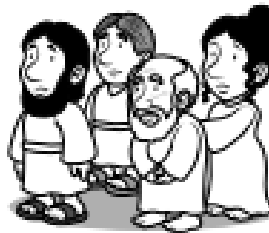

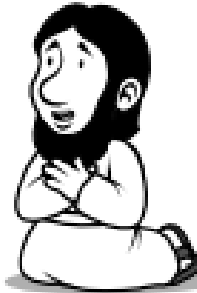

MEN'S ROSARY CRUSADE 1st Saturdays of each month at Wingham

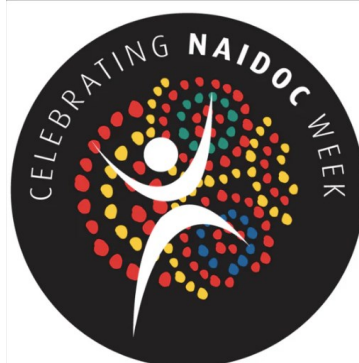
The gathering will be held at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church, 8 Farquhar Street Wingham.
